By creating better access to education, we can have a lasting and positive impact on Mali. For example, with each additional year of secondary schooling, a student's future income increases by 10–20 percent. And studies show that for each 10 percent increase in a country's middle school enrollment, the risk of war decreases by 3 percent...making us all safer given the interconnectedness of today's world.

So education, and increasingly secondary education, is key. Yet with all the good work being done to increase primary school access, there has been less focus on secondary schools. In fact, Although 69 percent of children are enrolled in primary school in Mali, only 34 percent are enrolled in secondary school.

That's where, with the help of sponsors like you, Mali Rising steps in! We invest in middle schools (grades 7-9) that help kids take the next step on the road to self-sufficiency -- because education is what will allow the people of Mali to take control of their own lives and the future of their country.

For 20 years, Mali Rising Foundation has worked in partnership with the people of Mali to bring life-changing education to remote villages in the country's southern region.

With the support of our sponsors, we focus on providing access to a quality middle school education in these remote areas. To date, we have built 28 middle schools in partnership with parents, village elders, and local authorities.

But we don't just build a school and walk away. Mali Rising's programs surround students with everything they need to turn a school building into a real chance at life-changing education. For example, we provide special programming to help girls get into school and thrive there; teacher training; textbooks and other learning materials; scholarships for continuing education; parental engagement support; and much more.

So when donors sponsor a Mali Rising school, they aren't just underwriting concrete and metal struts — they are making sure kids have everything they need to build a better life for themselves and a brighter future for the world.

School Build Model

Your Build-A-School donation of \$50,000 goes far in Mali. Your sponsorship is leveraged by the village, which donates 20% of the construction cost and the land to build the school. Our staff ensures a quality build and ensures a safe, healthy place for students to grow.



PROVEN MODEL

Your sponsorship allows the construction of three classrooms, 6 latrines, and a principal's office/storage area. This is a proven model that uses simple, solid construction that lasts for decades with modest maintenance.



LOCAL INVESTMENT

Local investment in your school is critical for its longterm success. The village donates 20% of construction costs and the land for the school. Local authorities staff the school with teachers. This partnership ensures the school is sustainable over the long haul.

Service Opportunities



Write Notes of Encouragement

Volunteers write brief notes in English (or French) to our students encouraging them to stay in school and study hard. Notes are hand-delivered to students to provide reading practice, fun, and a sense of support for their hard work. Thousands of notes are needed so this is a great project for large groups, but small groups or solo volunteers can also tackle this project.



Create Language Flashcards

Believe it or not, flashcards are seen as a fun, innovative tool in Mali classrooms! Volunteers make sets of French/English flashcards using word lists we provide. Drawings or art can be added to illustrate the words. This project requires some materials (cardstock for cards, etc.) but is well-suited for groups large and small.



Read to Mali

Volunteers read a favorite children's book or story on video. We add your video to our Virtual Libraries, which allows English teachers to use the videos for "story time" with a native English language speaker. Videos are VERY rare in the classroom so our teachers love how engaged the students are in these videos. This project is best suited for small groups or individuals.



Results

Mali Rising Foundation is dedicated to collecting meaningful data -- both quantitative and qualitative.

This means you can feel comfortable that our proven programs will deliver results for your school's students too.

It also means we can provide you with news and updates from your investment throughout the school year. This allows your media team to have on-going content -- extending your communication returns far beyond the first flush of school construction or adoption.
